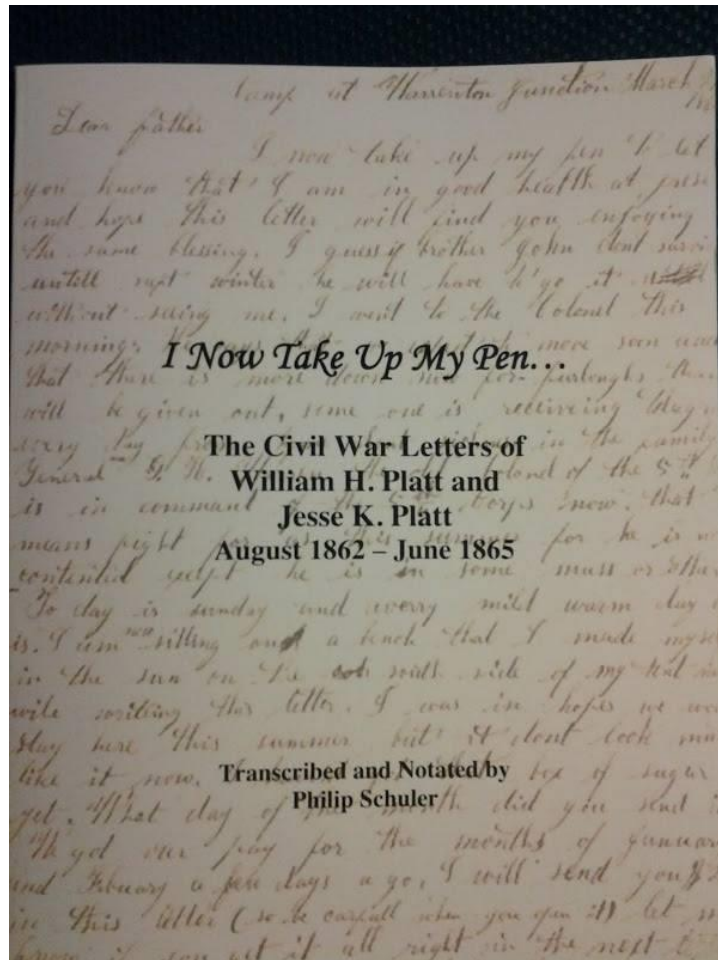


Miller Place-Mount Sinai Historical Society

Philip Schuler will discuss the Civil War letters between brothers William H. Platt and Jesse K. Platt residents of Port Jefferson as well as some that they wrote home. William owned Platt's Harness Shop which was located on East Main street.
